

SECTION VII. HEALTH HAZARD DATA

PRIMARY ROUTE OF ENTRY: Skin, Eye and Inhalation

EFFECTS OF ACUTE EXPOSURE:

SKIN: Will produce irritation.

EYE: Will produce severe irritation and may cause damage.
